Author Rights and Responsibilities

1. By submitting this dissertation/thesis/creative component to Iowa State University, I represent and warrant that my dissertation/thesis/creative component is my original work and if my dissertation/thesis/creative component contains any materials owned by third parties I have obtained all necessary rights or permissions to include them and my use does not infringe or violate any rights of others.
 - Examples of materials created or owned by third parties include but are not limited to photographs, extensive quotations, figures, and tables. Previous publications may also require permission from the journal or book publisher if copyright has been transferred.
